

# Downloadable checklist: Everything you need to prepare before travelling with your dog on Renfe

## Documentation

- ☐ Owner's ticket.
- ☐ Specific pet add-on for the dog.
- ☐ Up-to-date vaccination record, signed and stamped by a veterinarian, or European pet passport.
- ☐ Microchip registered with up-to-date contact information.
- ☐ Mandatory civil liability insurance policy.

## Essential Items

- ☐ Non-extendable leash no longer than 1.5 meters.
- ☐ Muzzle.
- ☐ Pee pad.
- ☐ Poop bags.
- ☐ Wipes.
- ☐ Disinfectant and deodorizing spray.
- ☐ Water and portable water bowl.
- ☐ Blanket or favorite mat.
- ☐ A quiet toy if it helps your dog relax.
- ☐ Your own protective seat cover or mat if you're travelling on a Media Distancia train.

## Before You Buy

- ☐ Check that the train is marked with a paw print symbol.
- ☐ Confirm that the dog weighs between 10 kg and 40 kg and meets the conditions for age and eligibility for the service.
- ☐ Confirm that the route does not include transfers or other forms of road transportation.
- ☐ Purchase the add-on well in advance. It is available for purchase up to 24 hours before departure, provided seats are still available.

## Before Leaving Home

- ☐ Take the dog for a walk so it can relieve itself.
- ☐ Avoid overly strenuous activity right before the trip.
- ☐ Feed your dog according to your veterinarian's recommendations.
- ☐ Check that your dog isn't vomiting, has no diarrhea, isn't in pain, and shows no signs of illness.
- ☐ Arrive with plenty of time to spare to avoid rushing.
- ☐ Use elevators or stairs instead of escalators.
